

Child Maltreatment Task Force Report Cecil County Community Health Advisory Committee July 17, 2014

Darkness to Light Training

- Sara Smith found a funding opportunity through the Health Department
- The funds were approved and we were able to schedule the Delaware YMCA to come to the Health Department to host a training
 - o Held on June 4, 2014 (2-4 pm)
 - o HD grant covered 50 persons tuition (\$10/person)
 - 45 persons were trained on how to identify child sexual abuse and how to report abuse
- A new online training module is available through December for free
 - At the next meeting we'll discuss potential public promotion of this free online training module
- YMCA of Delaware has asked us if there are Cecil County persons interested in facilitating the Darkness to Light training

Child Maltreatment Plan (DSS)

- In March, it was suggested that task force agencies take pieces of the plan, define the section, edit provided data (if needed), and connect identified best practices to the section
- In April, clarification was asked from DSS for expectations for usage of this report (due date for revisions?)
- In May, DSS confirmed that the plan needs updating and they will get back with us on next steps

Strengthening Families (Judy Center)

- Trained 30 persons to provide parenting and family activities to 10 families over a 14-week program
- Program will run in the 2014 2015 school year
- Locations:
 - o Gilpin Manor Elementary School
 - Thomson Estates Elementary School
 - Holly Hall Elementary School
 - o Charlestown Elementary School (beginning Jan., 2015)
